GOLF MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Playing Conditions

- When flags are removed from the greens, the course is unfit and **no play** is to take place.
- When the flags have been positioned on temporary greens, the main greens are out of bounds and must not be used.
- When the sprinklers are in use, temporary greens are in play.
- On rare occasions the course may be closed to Members due to unforeseen circumstances. **"Golf Course Closed"** notices will be posted at the Sports Hall Reception and on the golf course, and as much advance notice as possible will be given.
- During Club Competitions it may be necessary to close the course temporarily to non-competitors.
- During term time, Cranleigh School pupils have the right to play on the course at any time and must be given priority. Please let them play through.

Control of the course

Spot checks are made at regular intervals by members of staff and it is a club rule that Members must tie their discs to the outside of their golf bags in a prominent position, identify themselves when requested and leave membership cards at reception. Members must carry their membership card at all times when visiting the Sports Club, which must be produced upon demand.

Guests

Members may bring up to 3 guests per session, provided that green fees have been purchased from the Sports Centre. Individual guests are limited to a maximum of 3 sessions, after which time the guest will need to become a Member if he or she wishes to play any further games.

Handicaps

Once the work has been completed on the redesigned 4th hole, the course will be re-evaluated by the Surrey Golf Union.

Traditionally, Handicaps have been obtained by submitting 3 cards over 9 holes or 2 cards over 18 holes. Cards should be clearly marked "for handicap" and handed in to Reception. The score card can be signed by anyone with a handicap.

Members' Children on the Course

The behaviour of children is the responsibility of their parents/guardian. Children under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult. Children between 12 and 18 years of age may use the course unaccompanied by an adult, provided they have satisfied the Sports Club management that they are able to play to the required standard.

Etiquette

- Each player must have his or her own set of clubs.
- Only putters are to be used on the greens.
- Tee mats must be used unless instructed otherwise.
- Care must be taken not to damage the mats when taking practice swings.
- Do not drive off any tee unless the green is clear.
- Please replace divots, smooth out sand after bunker shots and repair pitch marks on greens. Please remember to replace rakes inside bunkers after use.
- Give way to faster games.
- Do not enter the garden of Spring Cottage without seeking permission from the owner.
- Priority at the tees must be given to participants in Club Competitions.
- Greens must not be used to practice chipping.

General

1. All persons allowed use of the golf course by the School and the Club agree to abide by the rules of golf as laid down by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews (R&A), including the rules of amateur status as defined by the R&A.
2. The Club agrees to abide by the rules of the Surrey County Golf Union (SGU) and of the English Golf Union (EGU)
3. The Club will comply with the regulations and rules of the SSS and handicapping scheme and any conditions imposed within the scheme by the Council of National Golf Unions (CONGU).
5. Local rules and etiquette concerning the Golf Course are as stipulated on the Club's official scorecard.
6. Acceptance of an offer of membership of the Club will be deemed to be an acceptance of the above regulations.
