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#### CAPITAL DONATIONS

You may wish to make a donation to the general Foundation fund, or to one of the specific Foundation projects that are ongoing. These currently include the Restoration of the Chapel; the new Art and Design Faculty; the new 1st XV Rugby Pitch and Club House, and the Bursary Fund for children from families in severe need.

The table below gives some examples of the final value various capital donations ultimately represent to the Foundation, once Gift Aid has also been added.

#### REGULAR GIVING

Regular giving allows you to support the Foundation in a structured and planned way, at a financial level with which you feel comfortable, while also helping to establish a lasting link between your family and the School.

Payments can be made on a monthly, quarterly or annual basis, and given over a finite number of years or as an open-ended pledge.

The table below illustrates how various levels of regular giving, again with Gift Aid incorporated, can make a significant and valuable contribution to the Cranleigh Foundation and the projects we are supporting.
