

## STATS AND FACTS | GCSE



## STATS AND FACTS | A LEVEL RESULTS

Cranleigh maintained its strong academic results with 75 per cent of A Level grades at A\*-B and an overall pass rate of 99.2 per cent. Forty-one per cent of A Level passes in the A\*/A category.

Nearly 20% of students gained A\*/A in three or more subjects and the following students all achieved **three or more A\* graded A Levels**: Olivia Chesser, Jake Harvey, Ellie McAleese-Park and Ali Johnston.
