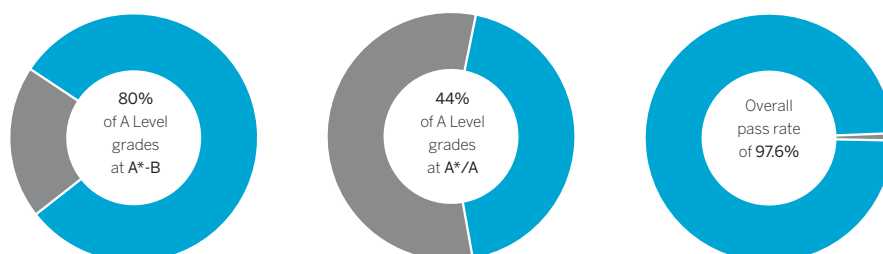
STATS AND FACTS | GCSE

Cranleigh maintained its strong academic results with 80 per cent of A Level grades at A*-B and an overall pass rate of 97.6 per cent. Forty-four per cent of A Level passes were in the A*/A category.

Nearly a quarter of all students gained A*/A in three or more subjects, with well over 60 percent gaining A*-B in all their subjects. Particular congratulations to Jordan Corbett, George Pettifer and Josh Wilkinson who achieved three A* grades, as well as Saskia Hogan who achieved a superb four A* grades.
