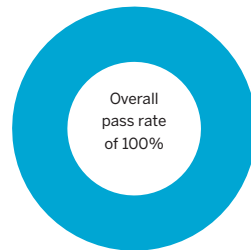
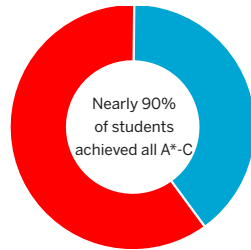
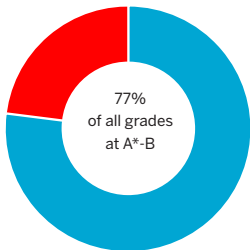
## STATS AND FACTS | GCSE

## STATS AND FACTS | A-LEVEL RESULTS

At A Level, 77% of all grades awarded were at A\*-B. Well done to Benj Chesser who achieved A\*, A\*, D1, D1; Ben Church who achieved A\*, A\*, D1, D2; Ella-May Jennings who achieved A\*, A\*, D1 and Georgia Murphy who achieved three A\*.

Sixth Form students also performed well in the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ), with 13 per cent achieving the top grade of an A\* and 80 per cent achieving A\*-C. Nearly 200 students in the Sixth Form take the EPQ in addition to three A Levels.
