This has become a firm favourite in our calendar, and features a semi-staged concert given by those pupils who specialise in musical theatre. There will be something for everyone...!

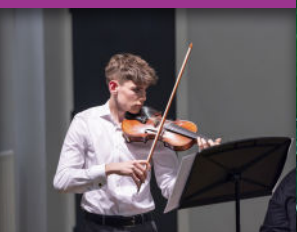
