

Pre-School Extended Fees Schedule

Sessions and Fees (as at academic year 2025/2026)

***15 Hours Funded Provision**

Cranleigh School will be registered to receive funding from Surrey County Council for 15 hours funded provision for 3-4 year olds in our Pre-School.

We recommend that children make the most of full days, where their development and progress will be seen most keenly. Our full programme has been thoughtfully designed to offer a rich and well-rounded educational experience, providing an excellent foundation for your child's transition to Reception.

Early Bird Club

7.45am to 8.30am £7.50 per session.

Children can be dropped at School from 7.45am. Please take them directly to Early Bird Club in the Pre-School classroom where they will be supervised by staff until the start of the school day.

Attendance should be booked one half term in advance, subject to capacity.

If you have two children at Cranleigh Prep, and the older child is in Year 3 or above, early morning care may be available for the younger sibling due to required start times. Please contact Admissions for further details.

After School Club

3.45pm to 5.15pm £5.00 per 30 minutes

5.15pm to 6.00pm £10.00 including tea

Children can remain at School until 6.00pm, run by qualified staff who will make best use of their expertise and the facilities to provide a stimulating and fun environment. Additional charges apply for each 30 minute slot until 5.15pm, with a 4.45pm collection coinciding with the end of the Pre-Prep activities and the last lesson of the Prep School. At 5.15pm a light tea of



sandwiches and fruit is provided until last collection at 6.00pm, with a separate charge applying to this later provision.

Attendance should be booked one half term in advance, subject to capacity.

Minimum Sessions

Children should attend a minimum of six sessions until the summer term prior to starting Reception, when they should extend to at least eight sessions in readiness for full-time schooling the following year.

Childcare Vouchers

Childcare Vouchers and Tax-Free Childcare accounts can be used to pay for fees and wraparound care up until the term in which your child turns 5 years old.
